## **Board Highlights**

The Board met on May 15. All board members were present and three residents attended. In the financial report, Stan indicated that HOA reserves of just over \$25,000 currently resides in a short term CD. How it may be laddered and where it should be invested will be addressed in future discussions. Around 94% of the HOA membership is currently paid up for their 2024 dues. Penalties and interest is now being applied to unpaid membership dues.

The wet weather has certainly highlighted drainage issues and the importance of appropriate drainage between lots. The Board is again looking at how the HOA might help mitigate these issues through the pre-build ARC process without taking on liability.

Wet weather has also brought forth weeds and lot owners are reminded that it is their responsibility to maintain their property. This also includes ALL lots and courtesy area frontage, whether a home exists, is being built, or vacant. Compliance letters will go out in early June. We also want to remind HOA members that all changes to landscaping and exterior features must be approved by the ARC.

The second information board is still on the agenda for the HOA Board to have installed. A new entrance sign at the upper end of Duke Parkway is also in the works as Ownership looks at providing an easement.

The Board is also working with Ownership as to the next step to have access to additional Greenspace.
